April 12th and 13th 2014 – Two days of fleet racing and no limit to number of participants.

April 12th, weigh in at 9.00 am.

April 12th and 13th Skippers meetings 10.00 am, with racing commencing at 10.30 am. No race will start after 4.00 pm, both days.

Where

Irene Reinhardt park Ellensburg WA (High wind Capital of Washington)
Lunch will be provided for both days. All skippers and helpers are invited to an after race no host dinner at a local restaurant TBD on Saturday at 6.00 pm.

Eligibility

Sailors with a certificated IOM that wish to have a fun weekend in Washington's high wind capital that have paid the \$40.00 entry are eligible to compete.

Current AMYA membership or equivalent is required. Yachts must comply with the ISAF-RSD, International One Metre Class Rules and have an IOM measurement certificate with sails that have been measured and marked by the measurer. No provision is made to measure boats at this event but all boats will be weighed in – fully rigged, with battery, fin, bulb and rudder attached. Provide your cell number on the entry form.
