When

February 7th and 8th 2015 – Two days of fleet racing.

February 7th, weigh in at 9.00 am.

February 7th and 8th Skippers meetings 10.00 am, with racing commencing at 10.30 am. No race will start after 4.00 pm, both days.

Where

Deception Pass State Park, at our beach on West end of Cranberry Lake, wet launch in fresh water. A Discover Pass or park entry fee is required to access any of the park facilities. Maps and camping reservations at www.parks.wa.gov.

Lunch will be provided for both days. All skippers and helpers are invited to an after race pot luck buffet Saturday February 7th at a location TBD.

Eligibility

Sailors with an IOM that wish to have a fun weekend in an outstanding park that have paid the \$50.00 entry are eligible to compete.

Current AMYA membership or equivalent is encouraged. No provision is made to measure boats at this event but all boats will be weighed in - fully rigged, with battery, fin, bulb and rudder attached.
