RULES: The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013-2016 (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E, the Championship Regulations of ISAF RSD, this Notice of Race (NOR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the International One Metre Class, and The Equipment Rules of Sailing. The Sailing instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to all IOM class boats. All entrants must be current members of AMYA or their National Authority and have a valid IOM measurement certificate.

TOP THREE FINISHERS from previous COW Cup are automatically entered by notifying the Regatta Organizer by the first 72 hours of the event registration, and then followed by completing the entry process by the entry deadline.

PERSONAL SAIL NUMBERS (PSNs) are granted if we receive a request to hold your PSN in the first 72 hours after registration opens. We will then hold your PSN until the entry deadline. After sail numbers are assigned on a first come first served basis by completing the entry process, regardless of PSNs.

REGISTRATION and EVENT MEASUREMENT: IOMs with a valid Measurement Certificate and AMYA/National Authority membership card shall be presented for check-in *Friday* at the gathering party or *Saturday from 8:30 – 9:15* at the sailing site. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has successfully completed checked-in for the event.

SCORING and RACING SYSTEM: Scoring will be carried out in accordance with HMS 2014 as modified by the SI's.

FREQUENCIES: Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands. Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified. Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis. NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor not using 2.4 GHz radios is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available.

FOOD: Friday Gathering Party includes appetizers. Lunch & water bottle provided Saturday & Sunday.

AWARDS: The coveted yet tacky Cow Bell prizes will be awarded to the first five positions in the final results.

CONDUCT: Poor competitor behavior can reflect negatively on the sport, <u>and all competitors are advised that their actions will be</u> <u>under scrutiny by race officials</u>. In the event race officials witness any behavior, which they deem to be a breach of good manners or sportsmanship, or which may bring the sport into disrepute, the Principal Race Officer assisted by race officials will protest the party (ies) in accordance with RRS 2 or 69.1.

The PRO, all race officials and observers have been directed to record any incidents, which will be dealt with to the full extent available to the Protest Committee. Penalties available to the Protest Committee include exclusion from the race in question or subsequent races, exclusion from the regatta, or other action within the Committee's jurisdiction.
