Deception Pass Model Yacht Club invites IOM International One Metre sailors to participate in the annual DPMYC Caper Regatta.

When

September 12th and 13th – Two days of fleet racing.

September 11th - Practice and early weigh in, from 11.00 am (optional).

September 12th, weigh in at 9.00 am.

September 12th, and 13th Skippers meetings 9.45 am, with racing commencing at 10.00 am. No race will start after 4.00 pm, both days.

Where

Deception Pass State Park Bowman Bay Pier – dry launch in salt water. A Discover Pass or park entry fee is required to access any of the park facilities. Maps and camping reservations at www.parks.wa.gov.

Lunch will be provided for both days. Early weigh in and course familiarization and practice is encouraged on Friday Sept 11 together with a no host reception at Village pizza @ 6.00pm (807 Commercial Ave , Anacortes 360 293 7847) . All skippers and helpers are also invited to an after race buffet at the Lee's home on Sept 12th at 6.00pm

Eligibility

Sailors with a certificated IOM that wish to have a fun weekend in an outstanding park that have paid the \$75.00 entry are eligible to compete. Current AMYA membership or equivalent is required. Yachts must comply with the ISAF-RSD, International One Metre Class Rules and have an IOM measurement certificate with sails that have been measured and marked. No provision is made to measure boats at this event but all boats will be weighed in – fully rigged, with battery, fin, bulb and rudder attached.
