2. Eligibility: The regatta is open to registered Dragon Force 65 One Design boats. Entrants must be current

members of the CRYA or their National Authority. Yachts must comply with the latest DF65

restricted class rules.

3. Entry: Entry fee is \$40, which may be paid at the time of entry or at the event.. Prizes will be awarded to the first

three sailors at the end of the event.. Lunch will be provided both days at the dock. Entrants will receive an event memento. A no host dinner will be arranged for Saturday evening, details will be made available as they

are finalized.

Paid entries with completed entry forms will be given preference over others. Entries will be accepted via regular mail and email. Entries should be in the hands of the Race Committee by August 23. Late entries may

be accepted after that date but might not be included in some event benefits.

Frequencies and sail numbers will be allocated based on the order of receipt of paid entries.

event Sis. The latest ERS, the DF65 Restricted Class Rules and/or any other prescriptions that may come into

effect by the time of the event.

Operation of Event

The event will be operated in accordance with; the latest version of the ISAF RRS as amended by appendix E and by the event Sis. The latest ERS, the DF65 Restricted Class Rules and/or any other prescriptions that may come into effect by the time of the event.

Entry level will be kept to 34 to allow no more than 2 heats to be sailed.

Depending on the entry level the event will either be sailed as a single fleet (max 16) or as two heats to make up each race.

If two heats are used then the event will be operated using the 6 boat promotion/relegation process. Scoring will be done using the HMS spreadsheet software.

If the wind permits, racing will commence after the skippers briefing at 10:00 AM each day. A break for lunch will be provided and no race heat will start after 4:30PM on Saturday or after 2:30 PM on Sunday.

An awards ceremony will take place soon after racing is finished on Sunday to allow everyone to start their journeys home.

Accommodation

Accommodation is available throughout the Richmond area. Please ask if you would like to be on the billeting list. There is limited billeting on a first come first served basis

Check In and Measurement

Check in will close at 9:50AM on Saturday. A signed copy of the entry form must be given to the race committee before that time. All boats entered must comply with the latest version of the Restricted Class Rules. Random inspections may be carried out at any time. http://dragonforce65.com/one-class-rules/
