NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

This Regatta will be governed by: The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017/2020 (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E; The Championship Regulations of ISAF-IRSA; This Notice of Race (NOR); The Sailing Instructions (SI); The International One Metre Class Rules; HMS (current edition); The Equipment Rules of Sailing.

The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race

WEIGHT CHECKS: At the discretion of the Race Director, weight checks of randomly selected boats may be conducted during the event.

FREQUENCIES: Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands. Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified. Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis.

NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor not using a 2.4 Ghz radio is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available. 2.4 Ghz radios are permitted and are exempt from rule E2.4 in the RRS.

PERSONAL SAIL NUMBERS will take precedence if numbering conflicts arise until 10 days prior to the Skipper's Meeting.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the IOM class. Each boat shall either send in advance or produce at Registration a valid Certification Measurement Form and proof of current AMYA membership.

3 REGISTRATION AND FEES

Electronic registration available on IOMUSA.ORG. Fees \$50 USD includes lunch both days and a \$10 donation to the NCA.

4 VENUE

Park Center Pond is a delightful medium sized pond in Boise, Idaho. It is close to housing and dining establishments and is a 15 minute cab ride from the airport. Ample parking is available behind the pond. GPS coordinates are on IOMUSA.ORG.
