1 RULES

This Regatta will be governed by:

The Current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) as changed by RRS Appendix E;

The Championship Regulations of IRSA;

This Notice of Race (NOR):

The Sailing Instructions (SI);

The International One Metre Class Rules:

HMS (current edition);

The Current Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS).

The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race

EQUIPMENT CHECKS; At the discretion of the Race Director, checks of randomly selected boats to insure they comply with class rules may be conducted during the event.

FREQUENCIES: Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands. Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified. Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis.

NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available. 2.4 Ghz radios are permitted and are exempt from rule E2.4 in the RRS.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the IOM class. Each boat shall either send in advance or produce at Registration a valid Certification Measurement Form and proof of current membership of the AMYA or their National Authority.

3 REGISTRATION AND FEES

Registration is limited to 50 boats. US Entries only until May 1st, after which non-USA entries will be accepted. Electronic registration and payment is available on IOMUSA.ORG in the "calendar" section. Fees will be \$65 and include lunches on racing days.

16 CONDUCT

Poor competitor behavior can reflect negatively on the sport, <u>and all competitors are advised that their actions will be under scrutiny by race officials</u>. In the event race officials witness any behavior, which they deem to be a breach of good manners or sportsmanship, or which may bring the sport into disrepute, the Principal Race Officer assisted by race officials will protest the party (ies) in accordance with RRS 2 or 69.1.

The PRO, all race officials and observers have been directed to record any incidents, which will be dealt with to the full extent available to the Protest Committee. Penalties available to the Protest Committee include exclusion from the race in question or subsequent races, exclusion from the regatta, or other action within the Committee's jurisdiction.
