NOTE: The NOR for the Coastal Cup Series is an umbrella document and individual events in the series may choose to provide individual NOR and/or Sailing Instruction documents

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and including Appendix E and Sail Canada Prescriptions, as well as the Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) and the *International One Meter* International Class Association.(IOM ICA) Class Rules.
- 1.2 Where applicable, the *Simple Heat Management System* or the *Heat Racing Management System* may be employed.
- 1.3 Unless otherwise noted, sailing instructions for each event will be verbal.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Skippers of International One Meter sailboats are invited to compete in the series. Skippers must be members of the Canadian Radio Yachting Association, or their equivalent national governing body.
- 2.2 **Boats used in any event shall be accompanied by a Certificate issued by their National Authority**
- 2.3 Entry for the series is \$20, and is payable by cash, in person, at any event that does not otherwise have an entry fee.

6.2 There are no official prizes. Glory and adulation await the top finishers in the series.
