RULES: The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (RRS) as modified by RRS Appendix E, this Notice of Race (NOR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the current International One Metre Class rule, the 2017-2020 Equipment Rules of Sailing and the current HMS Rules. The Sailing instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to all IOM class boats. All entrants must be current members of AMYA or their National Authority and have a valid IOM measurement certificate.

SAIL NUMBER CONFLICTS will be resolved in the following order: 1. Agreement between competitors. 2. Personal Sail Number (PSN) If entry is completed 10 days prior to event start. 3. First come first served basis by date completing the entry process. See USA PSN at <http://www.iomusa.org/> if registered or [HERE](#).

REGISTRATION and EVENT MEASUREMENT: IOMs with a valid Measurement Certificate and AMYA/National Authority membership card shall be presented for check-in **Friday** at the gathering party or **Saturday from 8:30 – 9:15** at the sailing site. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has successfully completed checked-in for the event.

SCORING and RACING SYSTEM: Scoring will be carried out in accordance with the Current HMS as modified by the SI's.

FREQUENCIES: Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands. Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified. Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis. NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor not using 2.4 GHz radios is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available.

FOOD: Friday Gathering Party includes an evening meal (BYOB). Lunch & water bottle provided Saturday & Sunday.

AWARDS: The coveted yet tacky Cow Bell prizes will be awarded to the first five positions in the final results.

CONDUCT: Poor competitor behavior can reflect negatively on the sport, and all competitors are advised that their actions will be under scrutiny by race officials. In the event race officials witness any behavior, which they deem to be a breach of good manners or sportsmanship, or which may bring the sport into disrepute, the Principal Race Officer assisted by race officials will protest the party (ies) in accordance with RRS 2 or 69.1.

The PRO, all race officials and observers have been directed to record any incidents, which will be dealt with to the full extent available to the Protest Committee. Penalties available to the Protest Committee include exclusion from the race in question or subsequent races, exclusion from the regatta, or other action within the Committee's jurisdiction.
