RULES: The regatta will be governed by The **Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 (RRS)** as changed by RRS Appendix E, , this Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the Latest version of the DF95 Restricted Class Rules, and The Equipment Rules of Sailing. **The Sailing instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.**

ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to all DF95 class boats. All entrants must be current members of AMYA or their National Authority.

SCORING and RACING SYSTEM: Scoring will be carried out in accordance with HMS 2017 or SHRS 2018 as modified by the SI's. (depending on Number of boats entered)

PRE-REGISTRATION and FEES:

Entry fee is \$55.00 per boat and includes lunch and beverages on Saturday and Sunday, (Does not include charge to enter Park, \$5 per day)

Fees are payable online prior to July 1, 2018 and no refunds will be given after that date.

FREQUENCIES: Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands. Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified. Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis. NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available. **2.4 Ghz radios** are permitted and are exempt from rule E1.5 in the RRS.

FOOD SERVICE: Box Lunches on Friday and Saturday will consist of Jersey Mikes Subs and choices are available on the registration. If one has any special food requirements, please advise us.

AWARDS: Prizes will be awarded to the first 5 positions in the final results.

American Model Yachting Association, , Orange County Model Sailing Club, Orange County, regatta staff, and or any other parties involved in the organization of this event disclaim any and all responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and on the water as a consequence of entering or participating in the event covered by this Notice of Race.
