NOTICE OF RACE HELLY HANSEN NATIONAL OFFSHORE ONE-DESIGN REGATTA RADIO SAILING

March 20-22, 2020

Sailing World is the Organizing Authority for this regatta and San Diego Yacht Club is the Host Club and will coordinate race management in conjunction with Coronado Yacht Club and San Diego Argonauts.

This is an official US Sailing sanctioned event.

1. RULES AND GOVERNANCE:

1.1 The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), Appendix E, the current applicable Heat Management System (HMS), and the Equipment Rules of Sailing.

2. ADVERTISING:

- 2.1 Boats are urged to refrain from displaying advertisements for businesses or products competing with those of the primary and support sponsors of the event.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA, e.g., bow stickers, boom stickers, and/or flags.
 - 2.3 At the discretion of the OA, bow numbers may also be required for some classes. If required, they will be provided and shall be placed on both sides of the boat's bow.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to all DF 95 class boats.
- 3.2 The maximum number of entries shall be 40.
- 3.3 All entrants must be current members of their National Authority.
- 3.4 Entries shall be submitted by entering online at https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=9672. Classes shall meet eligibility requirements no later than March 9, 2020 and are not valid until accepted by the Organizing Authority. Late entries may be accepted solely at the discretion of Sailing World.

4. FEES:

4.1 Entry fee is USD\$75.00 per boat. Entry fee includes 2 beverage tickets

5. FREQUENCIES:

- 5.1 Permitted frequency bands are FCC-approved surface bands.
- 5.2 Transmitters on 75 MHz must be narrow band certified.
- 5.3 Radio frequencies will be allocated on a "first come first served" basis.
- 5.4 NO CONFLICTS will be allowed. Each competitor is required to have a minimum of three (3) additional frequencies available.
- 5.5 2.4 GHZ radios are permitted and are exempt from rule E2.4 in the RRS.











6. REGISTRATION:

6.1 Each boat owner or his/her representative must report to one of the set registrations to complete registration details. A crew member may check in for skipper, and a class representative may check in for multiple skippers if authorized.

6.2 Crew lists and waivers of liability must be submitted by registration. In order to complete the waiver online, skippers will need to complete the Crew List in the "Owner's Corner". Subsequently, individual crew members will be notified by email of their boat's entry and those crew members must follow up when notified in order to complete the waiver. A pdf version of the waiver will be available online as well as paper copies at registration however, to speed up the registration process we encourage you to complete your waivers online. No boat's registration will be final without a completed waiver from each participating crew member.

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13.2 The Skipper/Owner of each boat participating in the regatta shall be responsible for the behavior of each member of the crew of his/her boat both on the water and while ashore. The destruction of property, the breach of reasonable standards of good sportsmanship by any crew member, or any other person associated with the boat, or the failure of any of those persons to comply with any reasonable request of any Race Officer, Regatta Committee member, or their representatives, may result in the disqualification of the boat, and its exclusion from the regatta.
