Notice of Race The WCRS invites IOM sailors to the 2020 Coastal Cup #1 regatta at Victoria International Marina

in Victoria, BC. The organizing authority is WCRS

**1. Rules** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current version of The Racing Rules of

Sailing (The RRS) and as modified by Appendix E, the Prescriptions of Sail Canada, the

Equipment Rules of Sailing, IOM Class Rules and HMS.

2. Eligibility: Entrants must be current members of the CRYA, or their National Authority. Yachts must comply

with the IOM Class Rules] and have a valid registration/measurement certificate. Proof of

membership and Registration/Measurement Certificate may accompany entry or be presented at,

or by, check-in.

No formal measurement will be done. Every boat attending must have a Certificate (and it must be presented) and all sails to be used must be pre-measured. Both of those must be present or

the boat will not sail.

Entry level will be capped at 18 boats. The size of the sailing area and restrictions on how long

the start line can be will mean that this will be a two fleet style of event.

**3. Schedule** Event Check in and measurement/inspection will be available on March 22, 2020 The scheduled

time of the warning signal for the first race is 10:00. No races will start after 15:00.

**4. Entry and Fees** Entry fee is [\$5],. Please make payment as outlined below.

You are on your own for lunch and beverages. There is a restaurant on site but the intention is to

keep sailing as much as possible.

Entries must be received no later than March 18, 2020. Late entries may be accepted at the

discretion of the Regatta Chairman.

Sail number conflicts will be resolved based on the date of receipt of paid entries including those
