The Class Rule is the International One Metre (IOM)

The Equipment Rules of Sailing 2017-2020,

The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race

1.2 CHANGES TO RACING RULES OF SAILING (RRS):

1.2.1 RRS E1.1 (Definitions): the following is changed to: "A boat is *disabled* while she is unable to continue competitively in the heat".

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY: The regatta is open to all boats of the International One Metre (IOM) class and a paid-up member of AMYA/National Authority.

3. **PRE-REGISTRATION:** Pre-register is required on or before April 8th, see last page of this NoR.

4. REGISTRATION & EVENT MEASUREMENT/CERTIFICATION CHECK: IOMs with a valid Measurement Certificate and AMYA/National Authority membership card shall be presented for check-in at the Friday Gathering. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has successfully completed checked-in for the event.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: Will be available prior to the skippers meeting.

6. SCORING SYSTEM: The regatta will be raced and scored using the current Heat Management System (HMS).

8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

All those entering or taking part in this regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. WORLD SAILING, IRSA, IOM ICA, AMYA, USA IOM NCA, Seattle Model Yacht Club, Regatta Staff and any other parties involved in the organization of this event disclaim any and all responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and on the water as a consequence of entering or participating in the event covered by this Notice of Race.

At all times the responsibility for the safety of their boat and themselves including the decision to participate or continue shall rest with the competitors. By entering this event, it is deemed that you accept these conditions. Competitors are advised to ensure that they have adequate insurance that provides coverage for public liability and their possible injury in the Country and County of this event.

9. SAIL NUMBER CONFLICTS: will be resolved in the following order: 1. Agreement between competitors. 2. Personal Sail Number (PSN) If entry is completed 10 days prior to event start. 3. First come first served basis by date completing the entry process. See USA PSN at <u>http://www.iomusa.org/</u> if registered.

10. EVENT MEASUREMENT: IOMs with a valid Measurement Certificate and AMYA/National Authority membership card shall be presented for check-in *Friday from 3PM – 8PM* at the gathering party or *Saturday*

morning *from 8:30 – 9:15* at the Hampton Inn. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has successfully completed checked-in for the event.

11. FOOD: Friday Gathering Party includes appetizers and dinner. Lunch & water bottle provided Saturday & Sunday.

12. AWARDS: The coveted yet tacky Cow Bell prizes will be awarded to the first five positions in the final results.

13. ACCOMODATIONS: There are many hotel options at the nearby SeaTac Airport and even closer in Renton. A few of the closest options:

The PRO, all race officials and observers have been directed to record any incidents, which will be dealt with to the full extent available to the Protest Committee. Penalties available to the Protest Committee include exclusion from the race in question or subsequent races, exclusion from the regatta, or other action within the Committee's jurisdiction.
